- 5. How might you make an ethical appeal on behalf of preserving or restoring wetlands? What might be morally wrong about not preserving or restoring them?

- 1. What facts does the author quote as evidence of wetland degradation?
- 2. What are the primary causes of wetland degradation?
- 3. In arguing his defense of the wetlands, that author asserts that they must be "allowed to endure as sanctuaries" of what?
- 5. What historical examples are cited to support the author's claims?
- 6. Who does the author quote to support his argument for preservation and/or restoration?

Solutions (chose one).

- 1. What solution is proposed for restoring wetlands?
- 2. What actions have been taken in the effort to preserve the extinction of wetland species?
- 3. What facts are cited as evidence of the problem?
- 4. Who is quoted as sources of this evidence?
- 5. What government agencies have taken this action?

Solutions: Freshwater Turtles (Do #2 and your choice of one other question)

- 1. How does the solution with respect to freshwater turtles satisfy the competing interests of "harvesters" and "conservationists?"
- 2. What is causing the rapid decline of turtles?
- 3. What facts are cited to support the claim that the plight of the freshwater turtle is but a symptom of a "deeper crisis that threatens biodiversity worldwide?"
- 4. What species were saved from extinction by an "earlier generation of eco-activists? What organization led this earlier effort? Why is that example significant for today?
- 5. What led to the catastrophic decline of these species a century ago?

Everglades Restoration (Do # 4 and one other question).

- 1. What progress does the author cite in the effort to restore The Everglades?
- 2. Who are the opposing interests in this conflict? What alliances were formed?
- 3. What has been the source of wetland degradation in this instance?
- 4 What are the details of this restoration plan? What is the "central element" of the plan?
- 5. What are the benefits in establishing habitat "corridors?"
- 6. Why is restoring wetlands an "ethical imperative?"
